- Embrace the diversity of Middletown
- Partner with Middletown Schools to improve educational system
- Examine Mixed-use projects like Hope VI to revive low income areas

## Improve City Image

- Street Improvement Program sign replacement, pothole repairs, striping, crack sealing, resurfacing projects, I75/SR 122 widening
- Enforce Property Maintenance and Zoning Codes
- Demolish or rehab blighted structures
- Work with Railroads to improve crossings
- Increased positive PR efforts
