Harold Forsyth Ambassador Embassy of Peru

Peru's government appointed diplomat Harold Forsyth as the new Peruvian Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the United States and gave him the credential letters and the respective full powers. Forsyth, who replaces Luis Valdivieso, served also as ambassador to China, Colombia and Italy.

The appointment of the diplomat was made official by a resolution published in El Peruano official gazette.

Harold Forsyth was born in Lima, Peru on May 27, 1951. He graduated in journalism at the Pontifical Catholic University of Peru and in International Relations & Diplomacy at the Diplomatic Academy of Peru. He also obtained a Master in Political Science at the Simón Bolívar University in Venezuela.

Forsyth is founding member of the Democratic Forum and of the civil association of electoral verification "Transparencia".

He was elected congressman of the Republic of Peru for the period 1995 – 2000 and was a member of the Committee of Transfer of the Government of Peru in 2001.

He has been Ambassador of Peru to Colombia between 2001 and 2004 and Ambassador of Peru to Italy between 2004 and 2006. During 2004 to 2005, he was also permanent Representative of Peru to the International Organizations with headquarters in Rome (Food and Agriculture Organization – FAO, International Fund for Agricultural Development - IFAD, and World Food Program – WFP).

In 2006 he was Vice Minister Secretary General of Foreign Affairs of Peru and was advisor of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Peru from 2006 to 2009.

He was Ambassador of Peru to the People's Republic of China from 1st August 2009 until August 2011. He was also concurrently the Ambassador of Peru to Mongolia and to the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
